### ❖ CLASSROOM SUPPLIES (REQUIRED)

Each student is required to have the following supplies available at student orientation. These supplies will need to be checked in to the office and shared by the DHPA classroom community. These items should not be labeled.

### ❖ STUDENT SUPPLIES

On the first day of school, each teacher will provide students with a class syllabus that identifies the supplies required for the class. Students will require typical daily supplies like mechanical pencils and lined paper, but the class syllabi should be referenced for all other classroom needs. If space isn't allocated in the classroom, the student is expected to keep these items in their backpack or locker. Student supplies will not be shared by the classroom community and will be the student's responsibility. Items should be labeled as needed. In addition to the supplies identified on the class syllabus, the following will be a requirement:

- Desert Heights Agenda (Required for 5<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> grade students and optional for 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Those 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who choose not to purchase an agenda will be required to have personal technology available in class daily to track agenda items using their school email/calendar/to do list.)
- High School Education and Career Action Plan (ECAP) Folder (Required for all 9<sup>th</sup> graders and new 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students.)

**Note: There is a limited supply of pencil sharpeners on campus. Mechanical pencils are requested and any students who choose to use pencils that require sharpening should bring a personal pencil sharpener.**
